



Student Scholarships

The BC Principals' and Vice-Principals' Association annually awards up to 20 scholarships, in the amount of \$1000 each, to students who are graduating from the BC public school system and will proceed to a post-secondary institution.

- Up to 10 scholarships are reserved for the sons and daughters of BCPVPA members.
- Up to 10 scholarships are reserved to other graduating students.
- Up to 2 scholarships will be awarded to Aboriginal students.

All applicants will be judged on academic excellence and demonstrated leadership within the school and community.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. **A copy** of the Ministry of Education's official transcript of **final grades** (this document is issued to you in August from the Ministry of Education), **which has been stamped and signed by a school official**.
2. Proof of paid registration at a post-secondary institution (a copy of tuition fee receipt or letter from the Office of the Registrar) (Note: A letter of acceptance is not considered proof of registration).
3. A short essay, up to 250 words, indicating leadership roles held in your school and community and your post-secondary aspirations.
4. A letter of reference from your principal or vice-principal who is a member of the BCPVPA (**children of BCPVPA members must submit a letter from a principal or vice-principal who is not a parent or guardian**).
5. One additional letter of reference.
