

13. TROOP 162 CODE OF CONDUCT

The scouts of Troop 162 will:

- Behave in accordance with the Scout Law, the Scout Oath and the Outdoor Code.
- Follow the instructions and directions given by adult leaders or scout leaders that are given to maintain safety, good order, or discipline during a scout activity.
- Consider the feelings of other Scouts and adults and will not do or say anything that will make others feel uncomfortable or threatened.
- Not be disruptive and will show the attention and respect that is expected of a scout.
- Bring to the attention of an adult leader or Senior Patrol Leader any situation that makes them uncomfortable.
- Not do anything that may cause danger to themselves or others.
- Respect the property of others and not take or damage property that does not belong to them.
- Not use electronic devices at a scout activity except when authorized to do so by a uniformed leader.
