25-50 feet of nylon rope (like Paracord)
Pad of paper and pencil
Repair kit
Needle, thread, buttons, safety pins,
 rubber bands
Large Garbage bags (2)

Wallet with money

Not allowed

Fireworks, ammunition
Fixed-blade knives
Knives greater than 4" in blade length
