Job Description: The Assistant Senior Patrol Leader is the second highest scout leader position in the troop. The ASPL serves in the SPL's absence or when called upon. He provides leadership to the other scout leaders in the troop. He is appointed by the SPL with the Scoutmaster's consent. A big part of this job is supervising the staff positions in the troop (scribe, quartermaster, etc.)

Duties:

- Helps the senior patrol leader lead meetings and activities.
- Runs the troop in the absence of the senior patrol leader.
- Helps train and supervise the troop Scribe, Quartermaster, Instructor, Librarian, Historian, Webmaster, Chaplain Aide, and other staff positions
- Serves as a member of the patrol leaders' council.
- Sets a good example.
- Enthusiastically and correctly wears the Scout uniform.
- Lives by the Scout Oath and Law
- Show Scout spirit.

Requirements: All requirements must be completed to received FULL leadership credit. Otherwise, partial credit may be given. Meet with your position advisor after appointment, each month, and at the end of your term.
