Job Description: The Guide serves as an advisor to the new scout patrol leader, teaches new scouts skills, advises the SPL and Patrol Leader’s Council regarding the needs of scouts not yet first class. The Guide must be first class or higher in rank. Troop Guides are appointed by the SPL.

Leadership Position Advisors: Adult – Assistant Scoutmaster
Scout - Assistant Senior Patrol Leader

Duties:

- Introduce new Scouts to troop operations.
- Guide new Scouts through early Scouting activities.
- Help set and enforce the tone for good Scout behavior within the troop.
- Ensure older Scouts never harass or bully new Scouts.
- Helps new Scouts earn First Class rank in their first 18 months.
- Work with the patrol leaders at patrol leaders’ council meetings.
- Assist the assistant Scoutmaster with training.
- Coach individuals Scouts on Scouting challenges.
- Sets a good example.
- Wear the Scout uniform correctly.
- Live by the Scout Oath and Law.
- Show and help develop Scout spirit
- Teach basic Scout skills.

Requirements: All requirements must be completed to received FULL leadership credit. Otherwise, partial credit may be given.
