Rotate duties each day as you wake up.

Cooking: Obtain the food from the camp commissary. Prepare food, cook meals. Keep cooking area clean. Set table. Prepare hot water for washing dishes. Announce Mess Kits. When ready to eat with all guest adults present, say the grace and lead your patrol cheer. Ensure everyone at the meal gets fair portions. After the meal, scrape food residue from kitchen dishes and deliver dishes to clean-up area. Ensure any extra food is properly stored.

Fire/Water: Set up cooking fire or stove, start and maintain cooking fire. Gather, stack and maintain firewood. Fetch, filter and maintain water supply for cooking, fire prevention and hand washing. Store stove away safely once it has cooled. If using propane bottles, deliver empty propane bottles to an ASM/SM for refilling.

Clean-up: Set up garbage bags. When Mess kits are announced, ensure adult guests are invited to dinner. Set up dish washing station, wash dishes and cookware. Announce when washing station is ready for personal gear (before the kitchen dishes). Dry dishes and store away. Clean eating and food preparation surfaces. Take trash to dumpster before night-time. Help keep campsite clean.
