Dave Dewey teamed with Lancaster Rotarian **David Uhl**, Rotary Foundation Chair of District 6690. Together, they provided an update and overview of how Rotary Foundation works. Uhl stated that Rotary is “one of the greatest charities in the world.” Rotary Foundation has maintained a 4-Star Rating by Charity Navigator scoring a perfect 100% in 2017. As Rotarian, we should be proud to support and be a part of RF.

Rotary Foundation splits their support into three categories: World Fund (50%), District Grants (25%), and Global Grants (25%). Examples of Global Grants for 6690 include Rotary Trade School in support of Mayan Families, Rafiki Children’s Center in Kenya, and clean water initiatives around the world.

Rotary Foundation is committed to a Polio-free world. 30+ years ago, nobody thought this was possible as it seemed too big of challenge. Thanks to support of the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation agreeing to a 2:1 support of Rotary Foundation, the Gates Foundation will be donating \$100 million in 2021. Polio now exists in only two countries -Pakistan and Afghanistan. The continent of Africa has been declared Polio-free. Eradicating Polio will take an estimated \$950 million to complete the initiative. Covid-19 has paused many vaccination efforts. Vaccination campaigns have resumed, but challenges remain to reach millions of kids that are in need.

Dave Dewey then reminded our club how we recognize giving. The designation of a Paul Harris Fellow signifies \$1000 of contribution to Rotary Foundation. Our club currently has 118 Paul Harris Fellows with many multiple + designations.

Polio Plus and the 125 club contributes \$25 to Polio Plus and \$100 to Rotary Foundation. All UA Rotarians that contribute to the 125 club are eligible for to win a \$200 Cameron Mitchell Gift Card. Dewey is also offering a World Polio Day promotion with the opportunity to buy a \$10 square (point value) for the OSU-Michigan Game that will contribute \$900 to Polio Plus and \$100 to the winner.

The Bequest Society is another way in which Rotarians can support the Foundation. If you are interested, contact Dave Dewey or Price Finley to discuss potential support options. As Dave reminded all, “Invest in Rotary, it makes a difference.
