



## Lowpoint-Washburn Remote Learning Guidelines

Parents,

In choosing to have your child learn remotely, please be aware of the following policies:

- Remote learners cannot return to in-person learning until the 2nd quarter. You can reassess your decision at the end of the 1st quarter (October 16th).
- We are returning to a traditional grading system for both in-person and remote learners.
- Attendance will be taken each day through electronic check-in with the 1st hour teacher (6-12) or classroom teacher (K-5).
- Teachers will provide learning through online instruction, resources, and assignments that will be listed on Google Classroom (3rd-12th grade) or learning packets (K-2nd grade). Parents are responsible for picking up and returning all materials as guided by the classroom teacher.
- School technology (computers, charging cords etc) are to be treated with care and returned to the school at the conclusion of remote learning.
- Any damage to school property (technology, books etc) will become the financial responsibility of the family.
- Students are expected to complete work in a timely manner and submit required work for grades and/or assessments.
- Go Guardian has been installed on all school computers which enables our staff to monitor the sites that are visited. School computers should be used only for remote learning and not for gaming, streaming movies etc. Our technology department has the ability to monitor each device and block any sites that are not school related.
- Teachers are available to answer questions each afternoon from 2:00-3:20pm.
