The enrolled agent profession dates back to 1884 when, after questionable claims had been made for Civil War losses, Congress acted to regulate persons who represented citizens in their dealings with the U.S. Department of the Treasury. Since then, these enrolled agents have been important advocates for Texas taxpayers.

These individuals assist taxpayers with issues from the annual compliance filing of their tax returns to more complex issues of audits, liens, levies, appeals and collections. In Texas, more than 500 enrolled agents have assisted over 750,000 taxpayers every year. Enrolled agents are licensed by the U. S. Department of the Treasury and authorized to be agents for taxpayers wherever the Internal Revenue Service has a presence.

At this time, I encourage all Texans to learn more about enrolled agents and the work they do to help taxpayers navigate the complexities and intricacies of taxation issues.
