RE: Cave Lake

After conversations with the state and Pike County Health Departments, effective Friday, May 8<sup>th</sup>, Cave Lake will be opening for the season to our **current pre-established camper base and the family members living in their home only. No guests** will be allowed at this time.

The following MANDATED HEALTH AND SAFETY PRECAUTIONS will be followed:

- ALL campers and YLA personnel will be responsible for maintaining the social distancing requirement of 6 feet apart. We ask when possible you wear a mask and use hand sanitizer, etc.
- ALL of our public areas will remain closed including the shelter houses, restrooms, shower house, play area, beach area, etc. You will only be able to camp and use the facilities in your own camper.
- We are NOT permitted to have group activities. Congregating in a group has to be less than 10 people at a time and the social distancing of 6 feet must be followed.
- If you have had a fever or any other symptoms, please follow the health department guidelines and do not come to Cave Lake until you have been symptom free for 72 continuous hours. It is the responsibility of ALL of us to protect not only ourselves but each other.

Camping rates – full summer rates will be in effect as of May 1<sup>st</sup>. HOWEVER, we will be giving a partial discount for this first week of May. We are working on adjusting the billing and will be mailing or emailing statements as soon as possible so we ask that you please don't call the office for your amount. This will slow down the process.

The YLA staff would like to thank those of you who have been patient & understanding during this pandemic. We have all been affected by the rules, regulations, loss of freedom and income and topped with hard unpopular decisions that have had to be made in order to protect each other. We are all in this together and together we will move forward in our new normal.
