When I (Joyce) saw this picture on the Internet this morning, I realized that was how I had been feeling. One person, alone before God, asking for answers. In July something happened on our website and we lost hundreds of links to our audio and video files. Over 50 pages were almost wiped out.

Another ministry said their computer department could redo all these pages and I breathed a sigh of relief. For close to 30 years, my part of our ministry has been mainly working with our website. These pages have been years in the making. I have moved on and now realized I had forgotten many of the parts of website design I had used before.

Gill Ministries, through your gifts, was able to say, "We can pay for the time your computer people need." We asked you and other donors to the ministry to help and we were able to make a donation establishing a "draw" account in their ministry. AL and I were praying daily for the people in their computer department. They wanted so much to do it, but the fall season is the busiest time for their ministry. After six weeks with about half of our website still not working, we had to face the fact that they had not been able to take the time away from their own pressures to redo even one page.

For six weeks the battle was on and I was seeking God's will. Was it time to delete all these pages? All the teaching files would still be on the Internet, but now there would be nothing pointing the way to them. It would pull our website down to a more "manageable" site. Was it time to just let them go?

Emails began coming from people using our website, "We're in the middle of a study of ... but now the links are not working." I was emailing back the links they needed to continue. It would be a better use of my time to restore the pages, I thought, but someone else had taken on that responsibility ... Finally, I said, "God I don't know what I'm supposed to do!"

**Then God!** How I love that phrase. Jerame and Miranda Nelson from the San Diego Outpouring were staying with us and speaking at the Healing Rooms. They didn't know anything about our website. We didn't talk about it. Monday evening Jerame was giving prophetic words to many. We could see their faces light up as they realized what God was saying to them. Then Jerame walked up to AL and began to speak to him. One part was about how God was going to use our materials during this end time restoration. He said they would reach even more people in the future than they had in the past. I sat there listening to him speak to AL, and I got it! God was not finished with what we were doing through the website. The next day I sat down at the computer and began to restore the first page. It can take several hours to do one page. Over and over, I asked, "Lord, how did I do this?" and I would remember, or know what to ask on the Internet for help. In two weeks, all the pages had been restored. Now I am redoing another 30 pages in other languages. One day I sat at my computer and laughed as I realized the Lord had shown me how to take out a couple of words and then a complete sentence written in a picture language.

Many have called, "AL, we have really been praying for you and Joyce, especially Joyce. Is everything all right? Do you need us to do something?" Thank you for all the prayers! They were needed, and God did answer!

# We Are More Than Conquerors!

AL walked up to my computer and seeing the above picture, made this declaration just minutes ago. The way he saw the picture was prophetic.

Yesterday, as I was working at redoing the Somali Language page I thought, "I don't even know where Somalia is. I went to the Internet and found the map. I sat there looking at it in amazement. How did our teaching get to the Southern Tip of Africa, and get translated into that language? I began thinking of the other languages and where they were reaching. I felt God say, "Consider the national landmasses of the world." Landmass was not a word I was familiar with. I looked up its meaning.

I didn't know how to do this. But I took Somali, the languages I had been working with and began to picture the area of land it had the potential of reaching; then French, Spanish, Russian, Korean, and on for 30 languages. I reached out to Jack Tuls of Remote Area Ministries. Jack and his wife, Grace, have been such strong partners to our ministry. They are responsible for many of these translations being done.

Jack understands numbers. He would know how to figure this out. He said he was surprised when he arrived at the answer! AL and I are in shock! Our minds immediately went back to a prophetic word we received in the 80's about how we would reach every continent of the world. Our immediate reaction had been, how can this be? A small ministry – an unknown minister – very little money – how?

The answer is simple. It's all of us, ministries and individuals, coming together, giving, praying, joining our abilities, our different anointings, building up one another to do what God has called each of to do. The answer is taking that first step trusting God for the fulfillment.

God said, "Consider the national landmasses of the world." The translations of our Kingdom Training Manuals have the potential of reaching 91% of the world. Going by nations, they have the potential of reaching believers in 68% of the nations. We are not saying, or even inferring that this is 100% saturation at any point. And we certainly do not feel this is what we have done. This is what God has allowed you and us to be part of!

There are 201 nations in the world. We have hits on our website from about 125 nations each month. Now consider other ministries and what they are doing. ISOM for instance, is working in 85 languages, they must have a potential of reaching 100% of the landmasses of the world. It goes on to ministry after ministry. We are doing what God has commanded us to.

**Go into all the world and preach the gospel of the Kingdom!**

Some go by praying - Some by giving – And some by going. It takes us all! Be encouraged, rejoice, give Yahweh thanks, not for what we have been able to do; not for what Gill Ministries has been able to do. Give Yahweh thanks for what He has been able to do with all of us working together!
