RE: Covid-19 Essential/Critical Industry Notification

As you are aware, a number of state Governors—including in Michigan, Illinois, and Ohio—have issued guidelines to help slow the spread of the coronavirus, some of which may order residents to stay at home except for essential purposes and telling nonessential businesses to stop asking employees to report to work
