At Scotland's Enterprising Schools we help schools to embed the Developing the Young Workforce strategy, Building the Curriculum 4 and HGIOS (4th Edition). We aim to increase practitioners' confidence by providing practical advice to help support the realisation of the ambitions set out in the Career Education and Work Placement Standard.

We support education practitioners to cultivate an innovative and creative curriculum that motivates young people to be all they can be in learning, life and work.

What Do We Offer?

Our CLPL sessions are tailored to support and inspire 3-18 practitioners and establishments with their enterprising journey. These offer:

- An introduction to Enterprise in Education and how practitioners can inspire all young people to develop a CAN DO attitude that will enable them to reach their full potential.
- **DYW** and the **Career Education Standard** contextualisation.
- Trainer-led activities and group discussion; introducing a range of teacher-led enterprise activities and guides designed to support teachers to embed enterprise education in, and across, the curriculum.
