

Dot to Triangle



Each player chooses a different marker. Now, taking turns and using a ruler or the edge of a book, rule a **straight** line between any two dots below and colour those dots in.

You can join any two dots as long as you **don't** cross a line of the opponent's colour, and you **don't** use a dot that's already been coloured in. Keep taking turns; if one player can't make any more moves, the other keeps going till they can't either.

Now, look for triangles made by **three lines of your colour crossing**. (If the circle of a dot is part of what encloses the triangle, that's fine, it still counts). Colour them in in your colour. If one triangle is totally inside another, then colour in the smaller triangle first. Your artwork is complete!

The player who has covered the **biggest area with triangles** (not the most triangles) wins. If you're not sure, whoever was able to draw lines the longest is the winner.
