

# Exquisite Walks



In this game you'll imagine going on a walk by drawing a map or series of pictures of things you'd like to see. No need to be realistic! Add giant owls or a rocket if you want!

To play, first, give everyone a copy of this sheet. Next: everyone should secretly draw in the **top section** of their sheet. Use the shapes: maybe a circle becomes a planet, or a huge face? Then fold the paper to hide your drawing, leaving a tiny bit at the bottom of the drawing visible, and pass your sheet to the next player. Take someone else's paper and continue their drawing, using the shapes and the bit of their drawing you can see to inspire you.

Keep drawing, folding and passing! When the sheets are all full, unfold the sheet you're holding, and talk everyone through the strange walk you've revealed.

The drawing template is divided into four horizontal sections by fold lines. Each section has a 'Fold here' line and a 'Draw to here' line. The shapes provided in each section are:

- Section 1 (Top):** A square, a vertical dashed line, two double-outlined circles, and a diagonal line.
- Section 2:** A vertical rectangle, a horizontal line, two double-outlined circles, and a diagonal line.
- Section 3:** A horizontal line, four single-outlined circles, a diagonal line, and a triangle.
- Section 4 (Bottom):** A dotted circle, a horizontal line, three single-outlined circles, a vertical dashed line, a rounded square, and a square.
