We've had a brilliant week in Class 3. The children have worked very hard and learnt new skills.

In Maths, we've learned how to round numbers and practised more add and subtract 1, 10, 100. The year 3 children are learning the 3 times table and the year 4s are practising the 6 times tables. Please, encourage your children to practise the times tables they know and the ones they aren't very confident on. For the year 3 children, please keep practising the 2, 5, 10 times tables (from last year) and the 3 times table (the new times table for this year).

In English, the children have written a draft copy of their own instructional text and have edited and improved it. Then, they have written their edited and final copy in their English books. They've done a brilliant job and they should be very proud of themselves.

We've been scientists this week and we've learned about states of matter. We've classified solids and liquids and have learned the properties of gas. Now we know that gases have a weight.

This week's spelling words for both year groups are homophones. We practised them in class and it seems that the children knew most of them.

In History, we have learned more about the Romans and we've examined, in particular, why they decided to invade Britain.

Next week we're celebrating Halloween in school (next Friday) and we're looking forward to seeing the children in their most creative costumes.
