*Aberfeldy, Bermondsey Street Bees Raw Honey, Lemon, Ginger, Aji Mango Chilli*

**RED SNAPPER ~ 10**

*Bombay Sapphire Gin, House Spice Mix, Worcestershire Sauce, Tomato Juice,  
Tabasco Sauce mini - tailor the heat to your liking.*

**HEDGEROW COLLINS ~ 10**

*Bombay Bramble Gin, Lemon, Orange Bitters, Fever-Tree Soda*

**LEMON VERBENA GIMLET ~ 11**

*Bombay Sapphire Gin, Lemon Verbena, Ferrari Sparkling Wine*

### ORGANIC WINE

- MÂCON VILLAGES, *Le Grappin, Burgundy, France, 2019* ~ 8 / 11.5 / 48
- GAMAY, *Kanon Keg, Domaine Saint-Cyr, Beaujolais, France, 2020* ~ 6 / 8.5 / 36



*Although vines are self-pollinating, the best wines are made from soils teeming with life!  
Bees need a chemical-free environment to thrive.  
When they do, they help to cross-pollinate cover crops, which allow you to be chemical free,  
avoid pests and have super healthy vines.*

*For Chelsea in Bloom, we have chosen to highlight two of our favourite organic wines  
made by two producers who champion cover crops and organic viticulture.  
Le Grappin's Macon Villages come from all-organic fruit,  
and Saint Cyr are the largest certified organic producer in Beaujolais.*

*These wines are delivered to us in Key Kegs which are made from 100% recycled plastic.  
By using this system instead of glass bottles, our shipping carbon footprint is halved.  
This year at The Cadogan Arms we will save 3.5 tonnes of glass by working in  
this sustainable fashion, with tasty wine on tap.*
