General Information

- AM exams start at 9:00am and PM exams start at 1:00pm.
- Students should arrive in the F6 foyer 20 minutes prior to the start time.
- Students should check their personal mock exam timetable carefully and report any exam clashes immediately to the Exams Office.
 - Further Maths students – should sit their ‘Maths A Level’ Papers 1,2 & 3 in the timetabled ‘Maths (for Further Maths Students) sessions.
- Students are reminded that usual exam conditions apply; no phones, smart watches (or other similar technology) and no notes are permitted in the exam room. Only clear and transparent items are allowed on desks. Water may be brought into the exam room but must be in clear / transparent bottle, free from all labels.
- All students should bring their student photo ID into the exam room to be displayed on the desk (as this is normal procedure for identification during public exams).

Exam Room Information

- All mock exams will take place in the F6 GSR unless otherwise specified.
 - Seating plans will be displayed outside F6 GSR during the week commencing 10 February 2020.
- Computer Science Paper 1 – will take place in Room 3
- Media Studies Paper 1 – the exam will start in S16 to watch media and then move to the GSR.
- Music Technology Paper 1 and Paper 2 – will take place in E18.
