

Data protection statement in accordance with the GDPR

Data protection statement for the applicants of the ‘Aviral Plastic Waste Innovation Challenge’ on storage and use of personal data by The Climate Collective shared in the application forms and through the program

Climate Collective takes the protection of personal data very seriously. This declaration explains what personal data is stored and what it is used for.

- The personal data specified in the registration process that is required for the purpose of Aviral Plastic Waste Innovation Challenge’, will be stored on servers owned by The Climate Collective and used for *selections for the program and the showcase of the venture*.

The data to be collected is as follows-

- Full Name
 - Email ID*
 - Contact Phone (With country code)*
 - Gender (not a compulsory question)
 - Information on themselves and their team members (Roles and experiences etc.)*
 - Country of Residence*
 - City of Residence*
 - Social media handles (not a compulsory question)
 - Business Information:-
 - Name of organization
 - Set of questions on business model of the venture
 - Recognitions and key achievements of the venture
 - Information related to competition:-
 - Questions related to their eligibility and the readiness levels for the challenge.
- The data will be used solely for the purpose of selection, communication about the ongoing challenge and to present the venture in a ‘Showcase’ to be developed.
 - The legal basis for processing is consent to this statement
 - The data will be used exclusively for the purposes described in the statement. Any other use will always be subject to further consent. Your data will not be used for advertising purposes.
 - The Climate Collective uses appropriate technical and organisational measures to secure data against unintentional or intentional falsification, destruction, loss or access by unauthorised persons. Access to your personal data is restricted to The Climate Collective staff, handling the Aviral Project, who need to process it for the above-mentioned purpose(s), and who will handle the information you provide in a proper and confidential manner. 5 staff members will have access to this data. Team lead, program manager, program co-ordinator, Social media analyst and IT expert.

- The data will not be passed on to third parties.
- Cookies are small text files that are saved locally in the cache of the user's internet browser. We use them for the duration of a session for the purpose of identifying users when they log in, selecting the correct menu language and ensuring smooth operation. Cookies can be deactivated in the browser. However, this may have a detrimental effect on the functionality of the application.

Rights of data subjects

You are entitled to enquire about your personal data, have the data corrected if necessary, and ask for processing to be restricted or data to be erased. The data will then be removed from our system. The consent given to use personal data can also be revoked at any time. This does not affect the lawfulness of processing up to the time of revocation.
