

General information about Group ‘D’ Exam Pattern conducted by various Railway Recruitment Boards (RRBs):

Two stages of RRB Group” D” Exam are as under:

1. Computer-Based Examination (CBT)
2. Physical Efficiency Test

The compute- based test of RRB Group ‘D’ exam is conducted for 90 minutes. A total of 100 questions are to be solved with **negative marking** evaluation system ($\frac{1}{3}$ marks for each wrong attempt) in the CBT. As per current exams patter, subject wise number of questions asked are as under:

Subjects	No. of Question	Time duration
General Science	Aprox.25	90 minutes
General Intelligence & Reasoning	Aprox.25	
Numerical Based	Aprox.25	
General Awareness & Current Affairs	Aprox.25	
Total	100 Questions	

It is observed that most of the questions asked in RRBs exams are based on general intelligence (equivalent to 10th standard school syllabus) and required updating current affairs.

There is no provision for Interview at any stage in this selection process.

Eligibility criteria:

- Candidate must have age between 18 to 33 years.
- Must be Class 10th pass or Apprenticeship Certificate from any recognized Institution.
