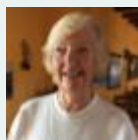

In March the R&A and the USGA finalised golf's new Rules

The process to modernise the Rules began in 2012 and was initiated to ensure that the Rules are easier to understand and apply for all golfers and to make the game more attractive and accessible for newcomers. The new rules will be applicable from 1st January 2019.

While the majority of the Rules remain unchanged there will be several important amendments in the following sections:

- Dropping procedure:
- Measuring in taking relief
- Removing the penalty for a double hit:
- Balls Lost or Out of Bounds: Alternative to Stroke and Distance
- Elimination or reduction of "ball moved" penalties:
- Relaxed putting green rules:
- Relaxed rules for "penalty areas" (currently called "water hazards"):
- Relaxed bunker rules:
