## An important note from GINS Treasurer

This is the time of year when all GINS members will be thinking of renewing their membership subscriptions for 2019.....well that is what I want you to be thinking about!! In December and January we try to get all membership renewals in by the due date of 31st December 2018

31st January really is an important date, because subscriptions outstanding afterwards means that members who have not paid cannot take part in GINS competitions.

But the real importance of the date is that I, as Treasurer, cannot budget for the year if people have not paid their subs; you will be aware that almost 75% of your subs go towards our prizes budgets for the weekly competitions at Anoreta, Baviera and Los Moriscos. Yes, your subscription includes prizes throughout the year; ridiculous value isn't it!!

It is many years since we have increased the renewal subscription. At €55 it is the best value you could possibly hope for, but only if everybody pays it. It is an annual subscription, like any golf club, and is payable in full whether you spend a lot of time in Spain or are only a winter or occasional visitor. If you don't pay it until you come later in the year it makes my budgeting for prizes very uncertain and could have the effect at the March AGM of your committee proposing a price increase for next year.

In this day and age, it is so easy to pay your subscription by online banking or electronic transfer from wherever you are, that there really is no excuse for delaying it until you come later (bank details are shown below) and your treasurer is then in a position to decide before AGM time whether or not to propose an increase for the following year.

So, I do ask that you give this matter your urgent consideration because this is the best value golf membership you will ever find anywhere.....what else can you buy for €55 p.a. that is better?

In January the membership secretary, Gill Green, and I will be touring our three courses for those of you already in Spain and who want to pay in cash. Those of you not yet here, like me, please pay electronically to GINS bank account. I have paid mine!
