Summary of Committee Meeting

Saturday 23rd February 2019

In Attendance

Erica Oxford (EO) Captain, Terry Everett (TE) Vice Captain, Robert Durston (RD) Secretary, John Conlan (JC), Derek Sibson & Ian Paterson

Apologies Keith Platt, Gill & Stewart Green and Rita McCracken

In Attendance as Guest Bob Merillees (BM) & Mike Bull (MB)

The Meeting opened at 10.45am

1. The Minutes of the meeting held on 19th January 2019 were approved and signed.

2. Captain's Report

- a) Ray Craig has investigated the possibility of Las Gabias Away Games being played on Thursdays only but has only managed to book a mixture of Mondays and Thursdays due to the course's other bookings. A list of future booking for this year has been prepared and will be distribute to SG so he can plan accordingly at Añoreta.
- b) The Away Trip starts on Saturday 2nd March and there are 40 players and 7 non players attending. So all 4 Balls! JC and Liz C are going early to the hotel to arrange a suitable programme for the non players
- c) Captain's Days confirmed as 11th March – Anoreta, 12th March Baviera and 15th March Los Moriscos. Ollie Craig, Liz Conlan and EO are arranging catering on the 11th holes. SG, IP and RM to inform the Course Managers of this. The prize money will be €5pp for the event. Course Reps to arrange prizes and will try to make them a bit more special than normal.
- d) The Dinner Dance arrangements are well under way. Break even for the event is 70 people and EO & JC will liaise with Bridget L/E to keep a track of numbers attending.

3. Vice Captain's Report

- a) TE distributed a complete schedule up to April 2020 of the known tournaments, sponsor days, special events etc. The dates were discussed and some amendments made where known. TE to send out revised list. Look at Los Moriscos Ladies Days and Glen Cowie Memorial.

4. Treasurer's Report

- a) Nothing to report from January accounts which consisted mainly of income with very little expenditure.
- b) As far as JC can ascertain Diary income will be €500 less than in previous years (€1,300) and the Committee needs to assess the situation if the attrition continues at its current rate. The Diary printing cost is €870
- c) After some confusion about a recent Hole in One it was confirmed that GINS "Prize" for a Hole in One is up to €60 on production of the relevant bar bill

5. Secretary's Report

- a) Arrangements for the AGM on 21st March are in hand and the Papers will be distributed to Members 16 days prior to the event with the Agenda (including any Member's Proposals), Minutes of 2018 AGM, Signed 2018 Society Accounts and 2019 Budget.
- b) Alan Edward's Proposal was discussed at length and the Committee remains committed to the agreed Proposal (which was almost universally accepted at the 2918 AGM) to charge all guests €10 per game with no restriction on the number of games played by a visitor. EO to speak with Alan Edwards to convey the Committees and the AGM's commitment to the fee to gauge his reaction and confirm his Proposal before the Tuesday 5th March

Handicap Secretary's Report

- a) DS introduced Mike Bull to the Committee as the prospective Handicap Secretary for 2019. MB will confirm his willingness to stand to RD before Tuesday 5th March. DS will propose and TE will second the nomination. DS has had telephone conversations with MB and has a meeting arranged to show him the systems and "train" him up for the position.
- b) DS opened a discussion on the World Handicapping System (WHS) which is due for implementation on 1st January 2020. There is no clear or definitive information available at present, but DS and his successor will keep the Committee updated as it becomes available. DS gave the Committee a flavour of what we might expect some of which seems quite favourable to Society Golf like ours and some of which will not be favoured by Members. It is a case of watch this space.
- c) DS highlighted a letter sent to the Secretary by Member Grant Turner (GT) suggesting a complete overhaul of GINS handicapping system to a friendlier society style one. RD has replied to GT confirming GINS current reasoning and DS will contact him to discuss the matter in more detail.

7. Membership Secretary Report

- a) JS gave GG's report in her absence. 230 paid up Members, 66 Pending, 2 Refunded, 1 Honorary Member and still 205 lapsed (which GG wants to clean up that list so that older lapses are archived).

8. Publicity Officer's Report

- a) RD reported on behalf of KP that KP would discuss the Web Page situation with DS who has in principle confirmed that he will look at the Web Page and Hosting once he has handed over handicapping duties. KP to ask Ascension if they will continue to act as Web & Hosting for up to 6 months during this transition period and to request all coding and information for DS to start his work

9. Añoreta Rep Report

- a) RD reported on behalf of SG that the ISAGENIX presentation had been postponed until later in the season due to a double booking by the company as they thought the day's game would finish earlier than it did
- b) Playing numbers are continuing to be greater than previous years

10. Baviera Rep Report

- a) IP reported that he will be using our own GINS scorecards at Baviera from 26th February which has space for scoring in both team and individual games and a place for the markers score as well. He will hand these out at the Desk.
- b) Baviera course continues its general improvements but the buggies remain an unreliable disgrace. RD reported that he had been told there was a serious potential buyer for the course.
- c) Although player numbers are not dissimilar to previous years he has difficulty some weeks with tee time bookings. He has to book all tee times 1 year in advance (2020 bookings being made shortly) due to a group which follows the GINS times. Whilst he is able to guesstimate these generally without a problem if such things as sponsorship day changes or additions are made he cannot always guarantee to be able to accept all Member or Guest bookings
- d) IR is encountering questions (particularly from returning members and guests) about whether GINS uses the Local Rule about OB and Lost Ball and 2 penalty strokes. RD confirmed the Committees decision not to implement that LR in light he CONGU decision not to allow it in qualifying games. RD suggested that all Course Reps have a single page laminated copy of the GINS LOCAL RULES clearly available at the Desk so both Members and Guests can check for themselves this and all other LR's
