Before moving to Spain in 2004 Dan worked in the Fire brigade and was part of their golf team.

He was known at El Puente by Antonio as Bombero Pequeno, which always made him laugh over a glass of vino tinto.

His jiving was legendary at the Gins dances, as was his ability to eat every dessert on the table!

Sadly his illness meant both he and Lyn had to give up the golf they both loved so much.

He will be dearly missed by all his family, friends, and fellow golfers.

Our Condolences go to his wife Lyn, who we hope to welcome back on the tee, as soon as she feels able.

The Meeting opened at 10.45am

1. The Minutes of the Committee Meeting 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2019 were approved.

### 2. Captain's Report

a) TE confirmed that due to family problems Bob Merillees (BM) would not be available to carry out his duties

b) BM has agreed to become the Federation Liaison person for GINS in a Non Committee role.
