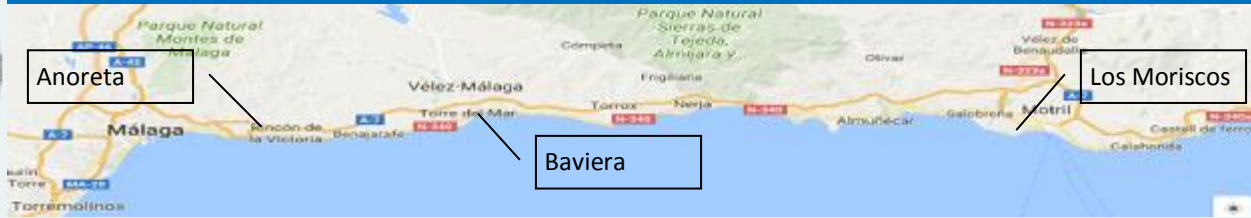

The course is less than 1km from the hotel and there is plenty of parking so no long distances between hotel and first tee involved. Golf clubs can be stored overnight at the course. The course is very suitable for GINS members as it is fairly flat and many people can walk, as they did last time.

### How much will it cost ?

Golf prices are rising all over Andalusia (thanks to Scandinavians mainly), and many courses we researched are just way out of our price range. However, Alboran and the Barcelo have agreed to take us again at only a small increase on what we paid in 2018.

## Minutes of Committee Meeting

Held on Saturday 25th May 2019 at Restaurante El Puente, Nerja 10.45am

### In Attendance

### Apologies

John Conlan (JC) Treasurer, Erica Oxford (EO)

The Meeting opened at 10.45am

1. The Minutes of the Committee Meeting 13rd April 2019 were approved.

### 2. Captain's Report

a. Dinner Dance, TE had received an email basically saying the Member was not happy with the Dinner Dance TE feels that it may be necessary to look and see if we need change of format. Perhaps a venue change (70-100 people space needed) TE was pleased to announce that Liz Conlan had agreed to become the organiser for such events in the future TE to write to Bridget Lloyd-Edwards to thank her for all the work she has put in over many years as the organiser of various social events.

### 3. Treasurer's Report

a. The Treasurer's Report and Accounts for April were presented to the meeting and approved

### 4. Secretary's Report

### 5. Handicap Secretary

a. MB is now liaising with Derek Sibson and the hand-over is going well

b. MB is looking at an "off the shelf" HCP Programme which will cost £100pa and will be taking out a 45 day trial. He will report back on its effectiveness for GINS,.

c. MB suggest that we appoint an Assistant HCP Secretary to help in this and also for absence etc

d. Although the World Handicapping is due to be implemented by January 2020, the UK has confirmed that it will not be ready by that date and it looks more likely for 2021

e. MB will co-ordinate a report on the changes he envisage once the COGNU agree,

### 7. Publicity Officer

- a. The website is being worked on and hopefully an insight can be arranged for the June CM
- b. It was decided that GINS would not agree to web mailshots
- c. SG observed that the "Absent Friends Day" scheduled for week 40 needs to be included in the forward Calendar

### 8. Anoreta Rep

- a. So far the numbers are 100 up on 2018.
- b. The course is playing extremely well.
- c. Anoreta have announced that it will be using 9 holes only during June/July and August to allow the complete re-make of the greens and other course improvements.

### 9. Baviera Rep

- a. Playing numbers are OK and the course is in very good condition
- b. Baviera are trying to sort out all the finances for Abonos etc before 15th June.
- c. After a slow play incident caused by visitors Baviera gave the main affected 4 players a voucher for 18 holes which was a generous gesture

### 10. Los Moriscos

- a. Playing numbers are still in excess of 30 per week.
- b. The Captain/Vice Captain format has been postponed but a modified competition will be played
- c. Change of Report The Wars of the Roses Match will now take place on Friday 28th June

### 11. AOB

a. RD reported that the revised Constitution was still on going and suggested that BM's resignation be deferred so that a coordinated EGM could take place in the autumn.

bc. RD explained fully the responsibilities of Members, Committee Members and The Officers of the Society basically saying that all Members are responsible for ensuring that overall GINS is run in accordance with its Constitution, its internal rules and the laws of Spain

and the Committee and Officers have the day to day responsibility reporting their actions to the Members.

c. RD reported that during the discussions with the lawyer about the Constitution it has come to light that GINS do not need to be Members of The FREG (confirmed after direct contact with the Federation) and that we should consider our position. The only benefits we currently enjoy with the Federation is that GINS can submit Teams to play in Federation Team Games (This does not affect individual GINS Members who are in the FREG and can play in their competitions as such, save that they will have to transfer their Membership to their Course Federation and Number if we leave) NOTE Originally it was a requirement in the Constitution that all GINS Members must be members of the FREG as well but this changed in 2006 (I think)

We also have the kudos of being able to use the FREG logo on our publicity! We currently pay c€1,600 to the Federation (which has been paid up to 31st December 2019) which if we do decide to leave this expense can be saved. RD and JC will triple check on this with the lawyer again. If the Committee decide that leaving is the correct thing to do, this point could also be brought forward at the EGM we will need in the Autumn so that we have full Membership approval.
