Dear Stewart,

First of all, we would like to send our best wishes to you, and your family and all GINS golf society at this difficult time.

As you well know, we were going to open today 11th of May, our team had everything prepared to fulfil reopening with all the appropriate safety measures to the current situation.

Unfortunately, the Spanish Government has declared that the province of Malaga will not pass to the phase 1, so we can't open our installations at the moment.

After the last appearance of the President of the Government and the announcement of the de-escalation plan to the "new normality", we can only say that we glimpse in a near future the reopening of our club, and will be possible next Monday 18th of May.

In this connection, we inform you about the lines that the Club Management is working to prepare our club for the reopening as soon as the authorities permitted:

1. We are working on the reopening stage next Monday, 18th of May, when Malaga would move to the first phase in the de-escalation plan, as long as Málaga was on that phase. will be allowed once we obtain the first de-escalation phase.

2. For your information, attached is the re-opening protocol prepared by the Golf Courses Association of Spain (PATRONAL AECG) and Health Ministry are approval. It includes all the sanitary measures that members, visitors and staff should fulfil to preserve the health and welfare of all people in Añoreta Golf.

- The bookings must be made on-line or by phone.
- The payment will be made on-line or with credit card.
- Buggies, trolley(manual and electric): before and after each use, they will be disinfected by the club staff.
- The Bunkers will be repaired in the best possible way by the player without use of rakes.
- The Flags on the holes must always remain in place, they cannot be removed or touched.
- The Holes must have a cap that prevents the ball from going down completely at the end of the hole. The player will pick up the ball with as much prevention as possible.
- The use of golf bag storage room are minimize.
- The dressing rooms will remain closed until authorisation from the Health Authorities.

In coming days, we will communicate the official confirmations regarding the reopening date and the measures adopted in the club to ensure compliance with the mandatory opening protocol for all the Golf Courses in Spain.

We take this opportunity to inform that, in accordance with the indications from the Government of Spain, we are studying the compensations that we will provide for the time we have been closed by Government order. We are presently immersed in reshaping the club in order to present the golf course and facilities in the best possible conditions. In addition, we will recover the administrative tasks in the next few weeks. We would like to give great thanks for your understanding and support in these closing days. This has given us strength and illusion to keep working in search of the constant improvement, to offer the best experience and continue to share unique moments in your club.

Letter from Fran at Los Moriscos to Ray Craig

Good morning Ray,

At the moment, we are waiting for some news from the Royal Spanish Federation and the Government. We guess the Sports Facilities without physical contact could open on the first phase of the soft opening (11th May). However, in some cases, some golf courses could delay the opening (*until Friday 22nd, probably like us*) a bit due to travel disruptions.

The main movement rule says within the alarm status: Until the third phase, you are not allowed to travel from your province to another. I mean, clients from Nerja or Torrox could not move from Malaga Province to Granada.

Otherwise, we have to enable the course with all the new protocols to guarantee the security of our players, workers, and suppliers.

The crisis is something important to take into account. It's very important to keep safe our clients.

We hope we could open in May, we will make the announcement of the reopening as soon as possible.

I will contact you this week with all the information.

And soaring, disappeared from view
Beyond the bunker's back -
A glorious, sailing, bounding drive
That made me glad I was alive.

And down the fairway, far along
It glowed a lonely white;
I played an iron sure and strong
And clipp'd it out of sight,
And spite of grassy banks between
I knew I'd find it on the green.

And so I did. It lay content
Two paces from the pin;
A steady putt and then it went
Oh, most surely in.
The very turf rejoiced to see
That quite unprecedented three.

Ah! Seaweed smells from sandy caves
And thyme and mist in whiffs,
In-coming tide, Atlantic waves
Slapping the sunny cliffs,
Lark song and sea sounds in the air
And splendour, splendour everywhere.

This poem was written by poet laureate John Betjeman about his birdie on the 13th Hole at St Endoc Golf Club, North Cornwall where he was an enthusiastic member. He had a house alongside the 12th hole, and when he died in 1984 his Coffin was carried the length of the 10th hole in driving rain by a cortege of the London Literary press all inappropriately dressed for "Poldark" conditions. He did indeed have the last laugh on the Sloane Street set.
