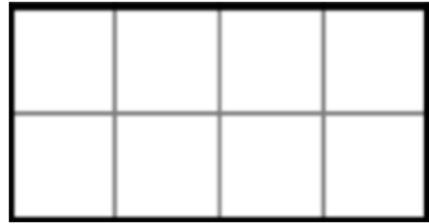
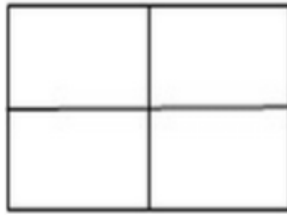
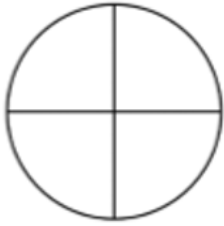
Role play scenes with props.

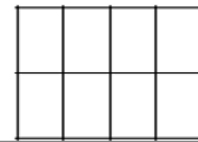
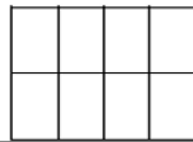
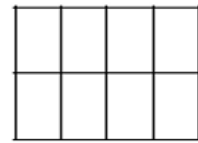
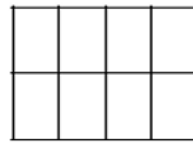
Colour in $\frac{1}{4}$ of each shape.



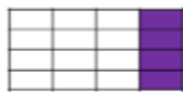
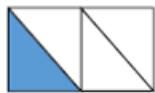
Colour in $\frac{1}{2}$ of each shape.



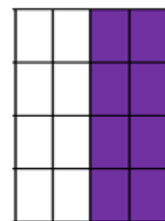
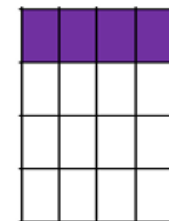
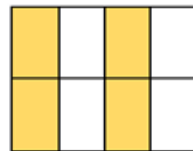
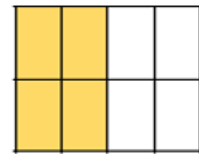
Colour in a half of this shape in different ways.
