You need to think about what characters are in the scene, what are they saying, what are they doing (written in italics) and what does the narrator (the story teller) have to say to make the play flow. Use the example below of Little Red Riding Hood. Then, have a go at acting out your script with people in your home.

Scene 1 - Little Red Riding Hood's House

Enter Mother carrying a basket of food, and Little Red Riding Hood, wearing her red cape.

Mother: Right young lady, I need you to go to Grandma's with this basket of food. She's not very well.

LRRH: Ok Mum. I'll stay and have a cup of tea with her too.

Mother: That will be very nice. Good girl. Now, off you go. And be careful going through that wood.



LRRH: I will.

Narrator: So Little Red Riding Hood trotted off with her basket of goodies for Grandma.
