clockwise three-quarter turn

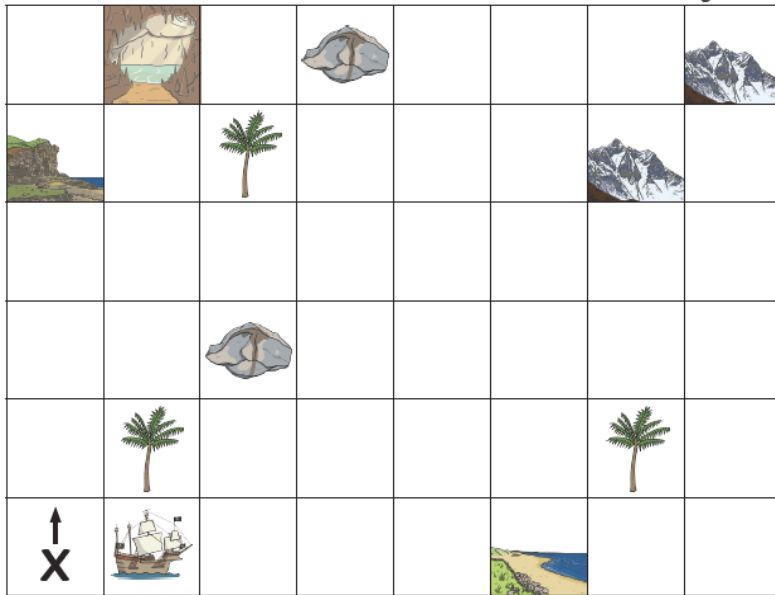
anticlockwise whole turn

anticlockwise half turn

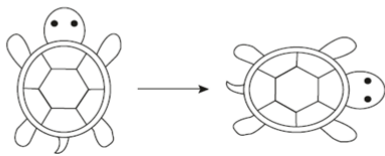
anticlockwise quarter turn (right angle)

This turtle is rotated **clockwise**.

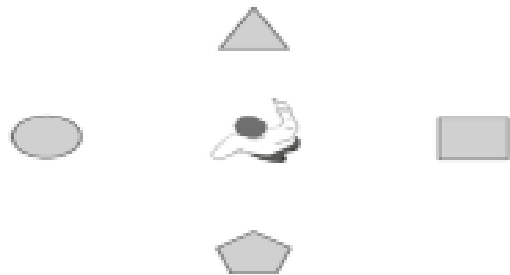


How much is the turtle rotated?

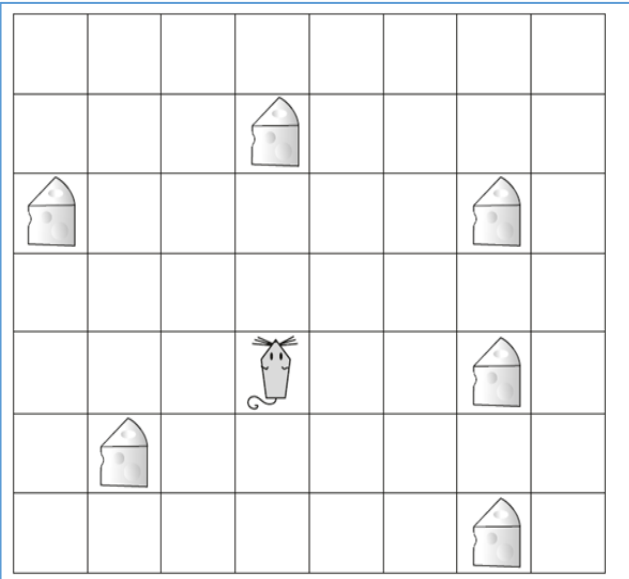

Look at the mouse.

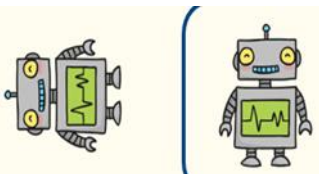
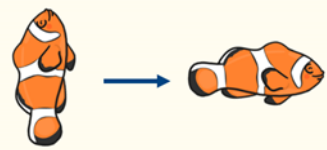
Ajay moves the mouse to a piece of cheese.
