### **Reading**

This week for your Reading Sessions, I need you all to read as much as possible on Bugclub to build up your fluency! There are a lot of books to choose from as not many of you have read many books on the level you are on. I need you all to try your best to read as many as possible over the next couple of weeks as I need to move you all onto the next level after the half term. I will be keeping an eye on Bugclub and there will be lots of dojos given out to the children who are challenging themselves.

If you do want to do something different, you can complete any home readers, reading booklets or KS1 SATs Reading tests you haven't completed in your home learning packs.

Remember, you should be reading daily for at least 30 minutes! Also, you should be reading around 100 words per minute if you are a fluent reader, which means moving your finger at a steady pace as you read (not too slow and not too fast).

### **Writing**

For your writing session today, I would like you to complete any of the writing activities in your home learning pack you haven't completed yet. There are lots to choose from:

- Talk for Writing- The Magical Teaching Box booklet.
- Handwriting booklets
- Practise spellings lists – Look, cover, write and check, using your cursive handwriting.
- Letter Join online, using your log in detail on the front of your plastic wallet.

### **Maths**

Today, I would like you to complete the Maths Booklets in your home learning pack. There is a lot of work in these booklets so don't worry if you haven't started them as you can continue through the activities in your own time. They should be completed in this order:

- 1) Working Towards the Expected Standard for Year 2.
- 2) Working at the Expected Standard for Year 2.
- 3) Working at Great Depth within the Expected Standard for Year 2.

There will be some tricky questions, particularly in the 'Greater Depth' booklet. If there is anything you find too difficult either leave it out or just ask me and I will explain.

If you have already completed these booklets, then use Mathletics! Lots of tasks will be unavailable at the end of the month so try and get as many of them completed as possible.
