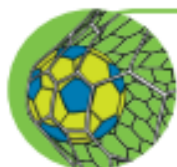

# Women's World Cup

The Women's World Cup is an international football competition. This means that teams from 24 countries around the world all take part. They will all try to prove that their team is the best at football.



This year, it will be held in France. It will take one month to find a winner, with matches taking place between the 7<sup>th</sup> June and the 7<sup>th</sup> July. The USA has won the Women's World Cup three times.

## The First Women's World Cup

The first official Women's World Cup was held in 1991 in China. 12 teams took part in the competition, with the USA beating Norway in the final. Since then, there have been six more Women's World Cup tournaments. The competition has taken place every four years. Before the first official competition, there were other unofficial tournaments. One took place in 1971 in Mexico.

## Host Countries and Winning Teams

Each time the Women's World Cup is held, it is hosted by a different country. These are all countries to have hosted and won the Women's World Cup:

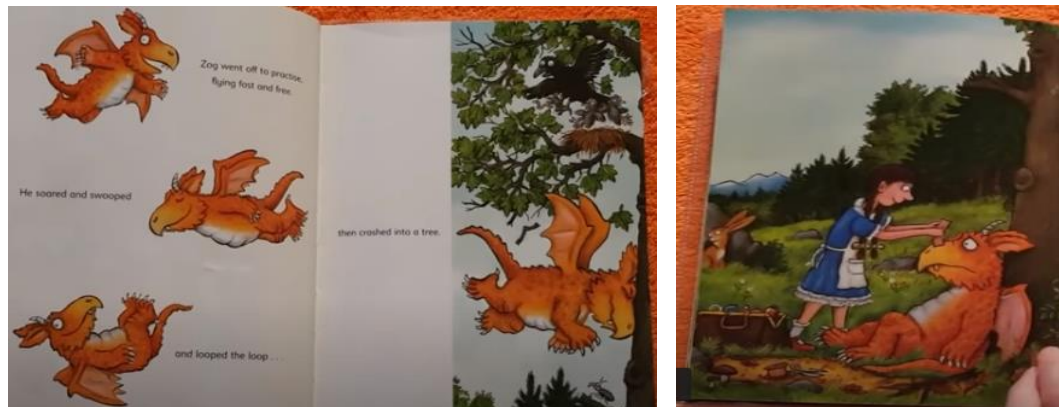





Remember, to work mentally you must only use your head and your fingers to help you.

These are our mental strategies:

Adding means counting on

Subtracting means counting back

Multiplying means counting on in groups of the same number

Dividing means you count in groups of the number you are dividing by, until you land on the number you are dividing. Then, you can count how fingers you have up, to work out the answer/ the number amount in each group.
