Reading

This week for your Reading Sessions, I need you all to read as much as possible on Bugclub to build up your fluency! There are a lot of books to choose from as not many of you have read many books on the level you are on. I need you all to try your best to read as many as possible this week and over the Summer so you are ready to be moved onto the Year 3 texts in September! I will be keeping an eye on Bugclub and there will be lots of dojos given out to the children who are challenging themselves.

If you do want to do something different, you can complete any home readers, reading booklets or KS1 SATs Reading tests you haven't completed in your home learning packs.

Remember, you should be reading daily for at least 30 minutes! Also, you should be reading around 100 words per minute if you are a fluent reader, which means moving your finger at a steady pace as you read (not too slow and not too fast).

Today, I would like you to design your own pirate ship. Below, is an image of the pirate ship from the story and there is also an image of a labelled pirate ship to help you to design your own ship and ensure you include all of the details. Give your ship a name too!










Now, I would like you to write some descriptive sentences to describe your ship, using **adjectives**, **similes** and **conjunctions**. I would like you to describe the appearance of your

ship and describe what your ship can do. Try and use lists of 3 with commas. Have a look at some of my example sentences below.

Roses Revenge **is as huge as Mount Everest!** It has a **gigantic** Jolly Rodger flag, **camouflaged** sails and hundreds of gun ports. The crow's nest is **wide so** you can fit more than one pirate in there at one time, to keep watch. Roses Revenge has **massive** cannons on board **and** they can fire off **as loud as fireworks**. Also, the deck is kept **spotlessly clean or** the pirates are made to walk the **long** plank! Roses Revenge can sail **as fast as lightning**. Also, it cannot be seen **when** sailing at night **because** of its **camouflaged** sails. Roses Revenge can submerge under sea **when** under attack!

Maths


Today, we are going to be refreshing our knowledge on 3D shapes. Use the poster to refresh your memory of the different names and properties of 3D shapes. Please note, a cone has a vertex (a point) not vertices!

tetrahedron		4	4	6


