Have extra tissues available If tissues cannot be reached in time, cough into the crook of your arm and then wash hands with sanitiser</p> <p>Regular contact with players' parents to learn if a player and anyone from their household has a COVID-19 case to update our coaches Anyone who develops COVID-19 symptoms or tests positive for COVID-19 MUST isolate for 7 days and will not be able to train for 7 days, from when their symptoms started</p>	3	5	15 - High	<p>Coaches to continually remind players/ Parents and Guardians about social distancing rules and will enforce them</p> <p>Everyone should self-assess for Covid-19 symptoms before every training session and match. If they are symptomatic or living in a household with a possible or actual Covid-19 infection they MUST NOT participate or attend</p> <p>Hand sanitiser is to be brought by each player and is to be used regularly and all coaches are to wear face coverings</p> <p>No touching, hand shaking etc is permitted</p> <p>Any members of the household who are classed as vulnerable are not to attend until further guidance from the government has been given</p>	5 - Med
