Children and their families will be asked not to return to the club for 14 days, or until a negative test result is confirmed All other parents will be advised of the situation and advice given according to the most up to date guidance In the event of a positive test the child and family will be asked not to return to training for 14 days from the test result, if they are still displaying symptoms then government guidance will be followed Risk Assessment reviewed regularly High touch equipment will be sanitised before and after training sessions If bibs are used they will not be shared and will be washed immediately after training 	1	3	3
