Covid 19 (Infectious Disease)	<b>AMBER</b>	<p>Social Distancing where possible with 1 metre plus as per government guidance (before and after a game and any breaks in play).</p> <p>Monitor and limit the number of occasions a team can play at the facility to ensure no overcrowding/congestion (only 2 games at the same time on site and max of 30 people training at one time on site including coaches).</p> <p>All players to bring their own drink bottle, hand sanitiser, medication, sun cream and come already dressed for the match.</p> <p>All Managers take responsibility to ensure all equipment is cleaned regularly (balls, bibs, cones, goals etc).</p> <p>Only coaches should handle any training equipment where possible.</p> <p>No shaking hands before or after a game.</p>	<p>Gain written consent via consent form or e-mail before any child can take part in football activity and make sure any opposition teams have the same for their players (keep safe and on file).</p> <p>Take extra hand sanitiser to matches/training and make it available to people (ensure all players and officials sanitise hands before and after a game as well as any scheduled breaks throughout a game or training session).</p> <p>Send Self-Assessment form to all players/parents/ officials etc (confirmed by parent for those under 18) and make sure they do a self-screen before every match or training session.</p>	<p>All Managers (Daniel Hyde to check)</p> <p>ONGOING</p>	<b>GREEN</b>

		<p>Travel to facility in your own car with members of your own family/household (no sharing).</p> <p>Substitutes and coaches must socially distance on the touchline and adhere to the government guidelines.</p> <p>Supporters/Parents/Spectators should remain socially distancing whilst attending. Groups restricted to 6 people and spread out in line with government guidance.</p> <p>Members/players/spectators etc must not attend if they are experiencing any coronavirus (COVID 19) symptoms. Encouraged to self-isolate and consult NHS 111 helpline or website and seek advice.</p>	<p>A member from each team to take down details of everyone attending the match or training session including contact details to support NHS Test and Trace (info kept/stored for 21 days in line with government framework).</p> <p>Make sure all First Aiders have appropriate PPE if they are required to treat anyone to protect themselves and others (where possible try and have a member from same family/household assist and treat the player).</p>
