Risk/Hazard	Level of Risk	Current precaution
Transmission/infection	High	All parents are messaged, through Spond, to advise about guidance before training and matches. Advice also states what to do if symptoms are present. Temperature check upon arrival.
Track and Trace	Low	All teams must provide full data for track and trace, players and any visitors included. Referee, linesmen, and any volunteers to provide details. Teams are advised about 1 parent per child.  Track and Trace forms are used for away games. Track and trace app currently being tested.
One way system	Low	Strict one way system in place, with signs and guidance.
Training/Match day	Medium	Coach to keep a strict eye on the session and ensure all players are abiding by the guidance and instructions Contact to remain minimal, Staggered, and increased breaks, numbers to be kept low and separate groups training. Players to keep safe distance during breaks. No sharing of bottles.
Equipment	Medium	Equipment only to be handled by coaches. Balls, bibs, and cones to be sanitised. Corner flags and nets are to be left out and only handled by a coach if necessary.
First Aid	Medium/High	For Minor injuries or issues and if safe to do so the player can take themselves to a parent for treatment. For a more serious incident the coach/First Aider shall administer first aid, following all recommended guidance.

## Risk Assessment – Covid-19

Car Park	Medium	Adequate space for all players and visitors. Car park attendant to be present as and when visiting teams are allowed. Both teams to not be playing games on the same day, or with adequate time between games.  Away team to leave first.
Entrance/Turnstile	Medium	Everyone to abide by Govt guidance when entering and leaving the ground. No meeting on car park and walking in together. No congregating allowed at entrance gate. Sanitise station situated after the turnstile.
Seating/Standing area	Medium	Social distancing to be enforced when using seats, every other seat to be kept free. Parents, spectators, and visitors to maintain safe distance when watching football. Seats to be cleaned. Sanitise station situated by seating area Social distance signs in place
Toilets	High	Toilets to be kept to 1 at a time. Sanitise station at entrance to toilets area.
Changing rooms	High	Remain closed following Govt guidance
Clubhouse	Medium	No standing at bar, seated while inside. 1 person at a time at the bar. Sanitise station situated at entrance.
Leaving the premises	Medium	Leave separately and not in groups
Hygiene/Sanitise stations	Low	Stations situated around the ground to be used only for the washing of hands or equipment and only to be used 1 at a time.
