<p>Car Park/paths/ patio/exterior areas/ touchline</p>	<p>Social distancing is not observed as people congregate before entering premises. Parking area is too congested to allow social distancing.</p> <p>Social distancing not observed on sidelines.</p>	<p>Marshalls in place on parents side at the school to ensure on social distance.</p> <p>Encourage people to park at a good distance from each other. This will be done prior to the game commencing and use of the 2 car parks.</p> <p>Hand sanitiser provided on arrival to school, car park and community centre.</p> <p>No changing facilities open.</p>	<p>Transitory lapses in social distancing in outside areas are less risky, the main risk is likely to be where people congregate or for vulnerable people. A person from redgate will offer sanitiser once in the car park. Alternatively sanitiser will be available in the community centre</p>
<p>Community Centre</p>	<p>Whoever plans to enter the community centre will need to register. Once inside hand sanitiser is deposited on all tables, Including toilet area's. After the game all tables will be arranged so to socially distance between each group(max of 6(to a table) Ordering drinks at the bar will be at the bar observing all barriers. Perspex screen is set up to protect bar staff.
