SHARE the Badge is a Strategic Partnership under Erasmus+ 2019-1-NL01-KA204-060481

About the project

In Europe there is a mismatch in the recognition of competences between employers and potential employees. Some vulnerable groups in society, such as migrants and unemployed with a distance to the labour market, have problems in showing the competences they have due to a lack of diplomas or certificates. These are the beneficiaries of the project SHARE the Badge which will be based on Open Badges and the SHARE method. The method was developed in a previous European project directed at young people in order to recognize and skills and competences gained from informal or non-formal learning. Not having a diploma or certificate, does not mean that a person has not gained competences. From September 2019 to 2021 the seven project partners aim to develop a Toolkit with offline materials for both, organizations and users, as well as a training course for organizations on how to implement the method within their contexts. The badges will increase the employability and at the same time strengthen the self-confidence and the active citizenship of the beneficiaries.

Activities

In November 2019, the seven partners held their Kick-off Meeting in Finland. The project coordinator Bloom Foundation provided detailed information about the project management and the planned work steps. Furthermore, the partners discussed how to promote the project and its results for the target groups and stakeholders. However, the main part of the meeting was dedicated to the first milestone in the project. All partners will conduct focus groups with relevant stakeholders in their regions in order to develop the planned project outcomes as tailor-made tools for the future users, both beneficiaries and organizations.
