What data do we collect?

MAC Ltd collects the following data:

- Personal identification (name, email address, phone number etc)

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide MAC Ltd with most of the data that we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- Enquire online or place an order for any of our services.
- Use or view our website via your browser's cookies.

How will we use your data?

MAC Ltd collects your data so that we can:

- Process your order and manage your account.
- Email you with information that maybe relevant to your service with MAC Ltd.
- Show you more relevant content on our website.

When MAC Ltd processes your order, it may send your data to and also use the resulting information from credit reference agencies to further prevent fraudulent purchases.

How do we store your data?

MAC Ltd securely stores your data on our internal system which is accessed only by MAC Ltd employees.

MAC Ltd will keep your personal information for as long as you are a customer of MAC Ltd and for up to five years after you are no longer a customer.

Marketing

MAC Ltd would like to send you information about our products and services of ours that we think you might like. We will require you to opt into any email marketing, and if you change your mind at a later date, will have the option of opting out again.

What are your data protection rights?

MAC Ltd is GDPR compliant and would like to make sure that you are fully aware of your data protection rights. Every customer of MAC Ltd is entitled to:

The right to access – You have the right to request MAC Ltd for copies of your personal data. We will charge a small administration fee for this service.

The right to rectification – You have the right to request that MAC Ltd correct any information that you believe to be inaccurate. You also have the right to request that MAC Ltd complete information that you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure – You have the right to request that MAC Ltd erase your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to restrict processing – You have the right to request that MAC Ltd restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to object to processing – You have the right to object to MAC Ltd processing your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to data portability – You have the right to request that MAC Ltd transfer the data that we have collected to another organisation, or directly to you, under certain conditions.

Cookies are text files that are placed on your computer to collect standard Internet Log information and visitor behaviour information. When you visit our websites, we may collect information from you automatically through cookies or similar technology.
