This leaflet is designed to help you to decide what action to take around symptoms and testing for COVID-19.



What to do if:	Action	Return to school when ...
<p>My child has COVID-19 Symptoms</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High temperature - this means they feel hot to touch on their chest or back. • A new continuous cough - this means coughing a lot, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours. • A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste - this means they have noticed they cannot taste or smell anything 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contact school to inform us. • Self-Isolate the whole family • Book a test • Self-Isolate until the test results are returned • Inform school immediately about a test result. • For a positive test see below 	<p style="text-align: center;">The test comes back negative</p>
<p>My child tests positive for COVID-19</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contact school to inform us immediately • Self-Isolate the whole family for 14 days • Agree on date for return - 10 days minimum. 	<p>The child who tested positive can return to school after 10 days if they are well. DO NOT send a child back who still has a temperature.</p> <p>The siblings of the child who tested positive can return to school after 14 days if they do not show signs of COVID-19.</p>
<p>My child tests negative for COVID-19</p>	<p>Contact the school to discuss a return date.</p>	<p>When the negative result comes back.</p>

<p>Someone in my household has COVID-19 symptoms</p>	<p><u>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contact school to inform us. • Self-Isolate the whole family • Book a test • Self-Isolate until the test results are returned • Inform school immediately about a test result. 	<p>The test comes back negative</p>
<p>Someone in my household tested positive for COVID-19</p>	<p><u>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contact school to inform us immediately • Self-Isolate the whole family for 14 days • Agree on date for return - 14 days minimum. 	<p>After 14 days quarantine.</p>
<p>NHS Track and Trace has identified that your child has been in contact with someone who has tested positive</p>	<p><u>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contact school to inform us immediately • Self-Isolate the whole family for 14 days • Agree on date for return - 14 days minimum. 	<p>After 14 days quarantine.</p>

<p>My child's bubble (class) is closed due to a positive COVID-19 test in their class.</p>	<p><u>St Paul's will contact you to discuss next steps</u></p> <p><u>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The bubble will be closed for 14 days.• You child will need to self-isolate for 14 days.• The rest of the household does not need to self isolate• If your child or anyone else in your household gets symptoms they should get a test.• Contact school to inform us immediately• Support your child with the remote learning provided by school	<p>St Paul's will send a confirmation letter/email detailing the date when the bubble (class) will reopen.</p>
