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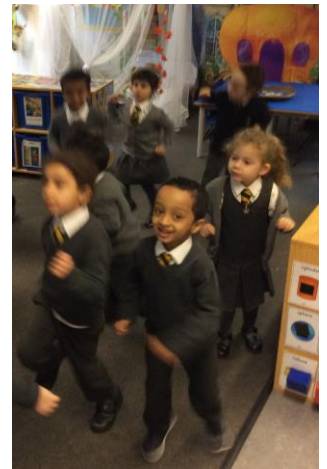
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Weekly Newsletter Monday 5th February 2018 Excellence with Compassion

Tomorrow is Safer Internet Day. How to keep our children safe online is an issue we are all very concerned about. In school we have safeguards in place to keep our children safe online, including filters, blocking of certain sites and discussing with the children termly within each new computing topic how to stay safe and what they should do if they feel threatened online.

However with the increased access children have to the internet, the rise in the number of children with smart phones and tablets, it is important to ask ourselves do we know what our children are accessing and are they safe? Mrs Gallon's talk will cover how to ensure our children stay safe online, the dangers we all face online and how as a school we offer guidance and support. Topics such as use of social media, cyber bullying and gaming will be covered as well as other sensitive subjects.
