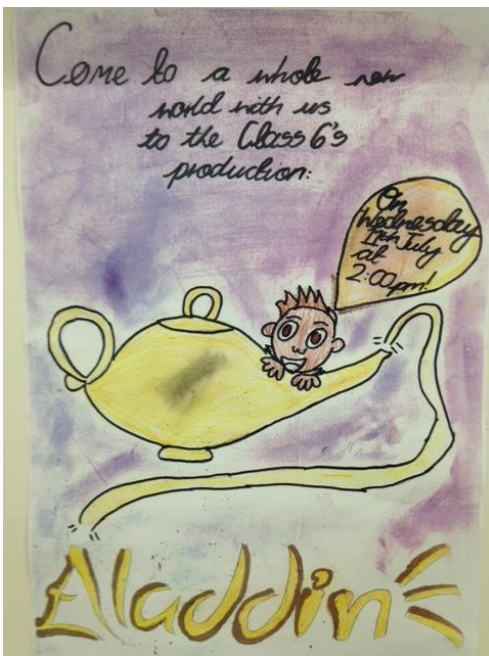
afternoon. Doors will be open to the audience at 1.45pm.
