


Last week...

Two classes were out on trips last week. Class 5 had another trip linked to their Cato Street Project. They visited the Household Cavalry and Westminster Archives. Also on Thursday, Class 6 took part in the Junior Citizenship Project. This took place at the London transport Museum and the children enjoyed taking part in different activities in preparation for moving on to secondary school.



World Book Day

In Family Assembly on Thursday, we shared the work we had completed during World Book Day. Every class looked at a story for the day, wrote their own versions or retold the story in their own words and created some wonderful artwork. Reception looked at the Hungry Caterpillar, wrote the story and completed some fantastic caterpillars and butterflies of their own. Class 1 read Handa's Surprise together, wrote their own stories and made some lovely collages of fruit from the story. Class 2 wrote their own whole class book about the Bad Tempered Ladybird and created their own collaged pictures, just like in the story. Class 3 wrote instructions for how to look after a Dinosaur and printed pictures of their own dinosaurs. Class 4 have been reading Charlie and the Chocolate Factory, they designed their own amazing sweets and wrote persuasive texts about them. Class 5 read The Arrival Picture book and wrote diary entries for the main character, they also created art based on the story. Class 6 wrote their own very imaginative fractured fairy tales and designed book covers for their stories. It was lovely hearing all they had been up to in family assembly!
