

Dear Parents/Carers,

COVID-19

As a school, we continue to monitor the current situation very closely. You may have seen the update from the government at the end of last week:

Symptoms of COVID-19 are:

- New continuous cough and/or
- Temperature

Government and PHE recommendations

If you have symptoms of coronavirus infection (COVID-19), however mild:

- do not leave your home for 7 days from when your symptoms started. This action will help protect others in your community
- stay at least 2 metres (about 3 steps) away from other people in your home if possible
- sleep alone, if possible
- wash your hands regularly for 20 seconds, each time using soap and water, or use hand sanitiser
- stay away from vulnerable individuals, such as the elderly and those with underlying health conditions, as much as possible
- you do not need to call NHS 111 to go into self-isolation. If your symptoms worsen during home isolation or are no better after 7 days, contact NHS 111 online. If you have no internet access, call NHS 111. For a medical emergency dial 999

In light of the current situation and government recommendations for those with coughs and temperatures, we will not be publishing weekly attendance for the remainder of the term.

We are suspending family assembly for the remainder of the term and after school care will finish at 4.30pm.
