Rewatch “**Please please the bees**” on Storyline online.

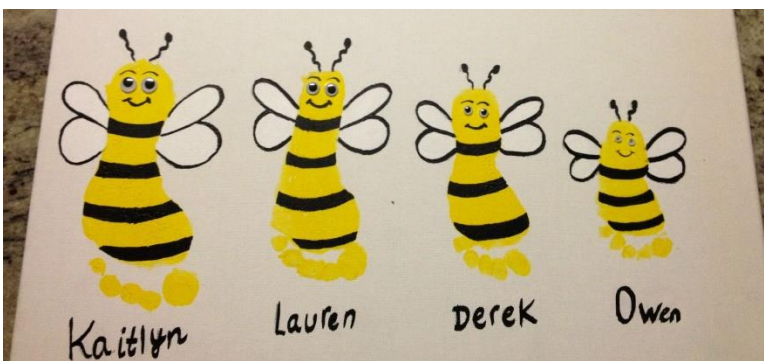

The bees are feeling unappreciated by Benedict. Make a bee themed card thank you card for someone you know that may feel unappreciated or that you would like to thank.

At this time, you may choose someone you don't know, but you would like to thank, such as the nurses, doctors, post people, delivery drivers, rubbish collectors. You might not be able to give it to them directly, but you could put it in your window for people to see.

You could include a bee themed sentence... such as “Thank you for bee-ing wonderful!”

As all of you will have different things at home to make a card with, use what you have. The pictures below are to inspire you, don't worry if you are unable to make any of these, as piece of paper with a lovely drawing would be great too!





Some of these have used cut up squares of paper, painted foot prints, heart shapes, drawing, printing bubble wrap, and cutting out hexagons.

When you have made your card, write a thank you note inside.

Remember to include:

Why you are thankful

Something nice about them
