

Literacy 4 - alliteration

Library Lion is an alliterative sentence. The sound at the start of each word is the same – **L**ibrary **L**ion.

Here are some more examples of alliteration.

She sells sea shells on the seashore.

Beautiful Betty buys blueberry pies at the bakery.

The skunk stunk sitting on a stump

Doug danced with the dog on the dock.

1. Can you write these sentences in your book, and underline the sound that is repeated in each sentence?
2. Can you create your own sentences that are alliterative? These could be about the lion in the library

e.g. The lion in the library likes to learn

Or they could be about yourself-

E.g. Ms Page is painting a pretty picture of pigeons and parrots.
