


Week 3 – mark your own work – answers





Write the times shown on these clocks.









2. Why does the boy erase the dragon prints? **So that no one will know about his dragon.**
3. What does mum say the dragon's roar is? **The sound of the ocean.**
4. What does dad say the feather is from? **A seagull.**
5. What does the big sister say the dragon's sharp teeth are? **Broken shells.**
6. What does the dragon eat? **Peanut butter sandwiches, brownies. (He also probably shares the marshmallows and drinks the lemonade)**
7. What do mum, dad and big sister think of the dragon? **They don't think he is real. They are a bit cross about the dragon game.**

8. Why does the boy stomp all over his sandcastle? How does he feel when he does this? **The dragon keeps getting him in trouble, so he stomps on the sandcastle so that the dragon won't come back. He is feeling a bit sad/cross/frustrated/irritated because he was having a nice day playing with his dragon.**
