


Learning in School

Covid Symptoms

If your child has a cough or/and a temperature please book a test for them. We appreciate this is not easy and there are limited numbers of tests available currently. If you cannot get a test, children must stay off school and remain at home for 10 days. Other members of the household must remain at home for 14 days or until you know that your child has tested negative.

It is important that we follow these rules (as hard as they are to follow and as much as we may not like them) so that we can work together to keep the infection rate down and avoid more classes closing.

If any members of your household have symptoms the children must also remain at home, even if they themselves do not have a cough or temperature. For example if a parent has a cough or/and temperature the children must remain at home. This is also why we are keen to get Google Classrooms working for us as soon as we can to ensure that the children do not miss out further on their learning.

If you are having to isolate, and work is not yet available on Google Classrooms, please do look back at the Oak Academy website as this still has work that your child can access.
