Covid Symptoms

To avoid similar more drastic lockdown measures that are being put in place in other areas of the country, it is vital that Covid rules are followed. If your child has a cough or/and a temperature please book a test for them and keep them at home. It seems that tests are more readily available now, however, if you cannot get a test, children must stay off school and remain at home for 10 days. Other members of the household must remain at home (including siblings) for 14 days or until you know that your child has tested negative.

On Friday we received a visit from our local MP, Nickie Aiken and Westminster Councillor Timothy Barnes, Cabinet member for Children's Services. They wanted to see all of the Covid19 measures we have put in place to keep children, staff and parents safe. As part of the Here We Are project, Year 6 had written letters to our MP about climate change and were using Google Classrooms to publish their letters when Nickie Aiken visited. She has



If any members of your household have symptoms the children must also remain at home, even if they themselves do not have a cough or temperature. Please do not send younger siblings to nursery or older siblings to secondary school. For example if a parent has a cough or/and temperature the children must remain at home. If your child comes into school with a cough or a temperature we will need to send your child and their siblings home. We truly share parent's frustration at this situation as we want children in school, but we also have to follow the government guidelines. Thank you for your understanding in this matter.

If you are having to isolate, and work is not yet available on Google Classrooms, please do look back at the Oak Academy website as this has work that your child can access. If you do not have a device to enable your child to access homework or work if they are isolating. Please let school know.
