Home Learning for Class 3

Dear Parents and carers,

We will be providing remote learning from Yr 3 from tomorrow.

We gave all children 2 exercise books (one with squares and one with lines) before half term, in case classes found themselves in this situation. Your child should (hopefully) therefore have 2 exercise books at home. If you do not have the books, please contact us and we will send some home for you.

Your child should log onto Google Classroom each day, using the same process they have been following for accessing their homework. At 9.45am every day, starting tomorrow and until Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> December, Mr Vanes will carry out a brief online register via live video. This is an opportunity to check in and say hello.

This is how you access the live video to take part in the online register:

When your child enters the google classroom at 9.45am a link to a 'google meet' will appear. To join the meet simply click on the meet code and you will be automatically taken to the meeting room in a new tab.



When you are ready to leave the online register, simply click on the red phone symbol at the bottom of the screen.

Mr Vanes will also upload a daily video/videos explaining what the learning is for the day.

In Year 3 the daily expectation for home learning is:

→ **Daily reading:** Aim to read at least 20 minutes with an adult.

→ **Daily SPAG (could be part of reading or English lesson):** Tasks focusing on the objective that your child will be covering depending on what year group they are in.

→ **Daily English:** Tasks will be uploaded to Google Classroom following the sequence of learning which would have happened in the classroom. The quantity of these will be dependent on the age/needs of your child. Some of these may need to be submitted via Google Classroom for the teacher to mark.

→ **Daily maths:** Slides and activities following the maths that would have been covered in the classroom will be provided via Google Classroom. Answers will be provided for self-marking at home.

→ **Science, RE and Creative Curriculum:** The tasks will follow the lessons that would have been covered in class during the week, which can most easily be adapted to remote learning. The exact subjects taught will depend on the topic being covered, and any 'missed' subjects will be made up once the class returns to school. This may include using the Government's Oak Academy lessons.

→ **Evaluation sheet:** Fill in the evaluation sheet on a daily basis to evaluate the learning tasks that were completed for the day.

If you have any questions, please do call or email the office or your child could message Mr Vanes using Google Classroom.

If you do not have access to a device, please contact school and we will arrange paper copies of work for you.

I hope everyone stays well and please do not hesitate to call school if you have any questions.
